It is notified for information of all concerned that the dates for receiving of examination forms and submission of filled in examination forms & fees for B. Ed 1st Semester (Regular) Examination 2019 and B. Ed. 1st (Supple – II) /2nd & 4th Semester (Supple-I) Examination, 2018/2019 have been fixed as follows:

- The Examination Forms will be sent directly to the colleges through e-mail : 9th November, 2019
- Date of Submission of filled-in Exam Forms (all pages) along with the Bank Draft of Exam Fees to the University Campus. : By 15th November, 2019
- Last date of Submission of filled-in Exam Forms (all pages) along with the Bank Draft of Exam Fees to the University Campus (with Late Fee @ Rs. 200/- per candidate) : 19th November, 2019

B. Ed. 1 st Semester (Regular) Examination Fees (payable by the candidate)	Rs. 800/-
Percentage of attendance condonation Fee*:	Rs.500/-
Review Fee for each Theory Paper	Rs.200/-

* Attendance condonation fee is to be given by the candidates with attendance below 80% up to 50% in Theory papers and 90% up to 50% in Practicum papers. Candidates with attendance below 50% in any of the Theory papers /Practicum papers are not eligible for appearing at the examination.

Exam. Fees for B. Ed. 1st /2nd /4th Semester (Supplementary) Examination, 2018/2019 (payable by the candidate)

Examination Fee for one Supplementary Paper	Rs.400/-
Examination Fee for two Supplementary Papers	Rs.600/-
Examination Fee for all Supplementary Papers (Theoretical)	Rs. 700/-
Examination Fee for all Supplementary Papers (Theoretical and Practical)	Rs. 900/- (Rs. 200/- to be retained by the college)

Note:

- An amount of Rs.200/- per candidate to be retained by the college for meeting up the expenditure of Practical Examination including remuneration and conveyance of External Examiner as prescribed by the University. Rs.600/- (Rs.800/- - Rs.200/-) per candidate is to be paid by the college to the University along with the filled in examination forms. The total amount of examination fee is to be paid by the college through Bank Draft in favour of **WBUTTEPA EXAM** payable at Kolkata along with two copies of forwarding letter having details of calculation of total amount of fees and one photocopy of draft.
- Spot payment of remuneration and TA is to be made to the External Examiner by the college.
- Hospitality and contingencies for the practical examination are to be met up from the retained fund.
- The Practical Examination Fee retained at the college over the expenditure met up for the remuneration, conveyance and hospitality will have to be distributed to the Internal Evaluators and to the non-teaching staffs.
- An utilisation certificate of the fund retained at the college for the practical examination along with the copies of vouchers will have to be submitted to the Controller of Examinations immediately after the completion of the Examination.
